

A Hive of Creativity **Guidelines for hand in of 2D, 3D, prints and cards**

<u>Hand in - Wednesday 20th November 9.30am to noon</u>

It is essential that all work coming into the exhibition displays the Unique Reference Numbers sent to you when you completed your Stock lists (these will be emailed to you once your 'stock list' has been received) and that the work is clearly labelled as per the attached guidelines. See below.

At 'Hand in' there will be separate Check in Desks for 2D, 3D and Prints/Cards

Jubilee Hall and Art in Poundbury cannot accept any responsibility for damage or theft of artwork left on the premises. Artists are encouraged to arrange their own cover.

Due to the scale of this exhibition, we cannot display any artists business cards or other promotional materials (apart from during 'Meet the Artist' sessions)

As this is a large community exhibition Art in Poundbury organises the hanging of 2D and placement of 3D throughout the exhibition. We aim to present as professional and cohesive an exhibition as possible

In the unlikely event that AiP cannot hang, or display, work we will reimburse you within 5 days.

Prints must come with a copy of your completed stock list emailed to you by Art in Poundbury

The following must be clearly displayed on back of work with a sticky label.

Artist name Title of work Medium Price

Unique Reference Number

AND

Work must also have a piece of string with a luggage type label attached so that when the exhibition is hung we can see what each piece of work is (for placing labels on wall purposes)



All work must be presented ready-to-hang, with D rings attached to the frame between one-third and one-quarter of the way down the sides of the piece

Do not use "snap on" frames, corner-clips with glass or "easel" frames designed for tabletop use.

Please take away any packaging material

Prints and unframed originals for browsers

Prints must come with a copy of your completed stock list emailed to you by Art in Poundbury
Your prints need to be labelled on front, top right with sticky label showing:-

Artist Name
Print Title
Description (eg. original, giclee)
Price


Unique Reference Number

Prints - maximum of 4

Mounted only, no frames
No stretched canvases.
No prints with more than 3mm depth

Wrapped in cellophane with label top right stating title of print, artist name, price and unique reference number

Prints must come with a copy of your completed stock list emailed to you by Art in Poundbury



Cards

All cards to be priced at £2, £3 or £4
No multipacks
No more than 30 in no more than 3 designs
All cards individually labelled on back atop right
as follows: -

Artist Name, Unique Reference Number and PriceBundled into each design with elastic band or string



Small 3D – plinth, shelves and trestle tables

3D must come with a copy of your completed stock list emailed to you by Art in Poundbury

Your name, price and Unique Reference Number must be on a label on <u>all</u> work (sticky or string label)

All items for table and spare stock (see below) must have your name and price and reference number on a label underneath the work (or small white tie label) securely attached

There will be different stewards each day and the more information given will avoid any confusion on payment.

Replacement stock box


Changes to the hall in 2024 mean we no longer have generous storage facilities for 3D. But we do want to be able to store some spare stock for you to be able to maximize your sales. The only way we can do this is if your boxes are plastic and stackable and no larger than

60cm x 40cm x 30cm

when something sells it will be replaced from this box

Label in large letters your name on narrow end of the box Leave a copy of your stock list in the box of the items you are leaving and make sure ALL your items are individually labelled and priced

Please ensure any fragile items are suitably protected



All other 3D - freestanding, wall and cabinets

If your works is easily portable please hand in on Wednesday 20th November between 9.30am and noon

For sales purposes, please ensure all work has a label (sticky or tied) with Unique Reference

Numbers, your name and price

If you have arranged to bring your own plinth please ensure it is clearly marked with your initials.

If larger (furniture etc) please discuss specific arrangements with Fiona Farrow (for delivery and placement of your work)
